Written by USCCB president Abp. Joseph E. Neither decision is rooted in the truth, and as a result, both will eventually fail. Today the Court is wrong again. It is profoundly immoral and unjust for the government to declare that two people of the same sex can constitute a marriage.

Jesus Christ, with great love, taught unambiguously that from the beginning marriage is the lifelong union of one man and one woman. As Catholic bishops, we follow our Lord and will

Pope tells Girl Scouts to oppose 'ideologies' against God's design for marriage



ROME, June 30, 2015

(LifeSiteNews) – Pope Francis told Girl Scout and Girl Guide leaders from across the globe last week that it is essential they promote respect for marriage and family according to God's design.

The pope's remarks came as both the international organization, World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts, and Girl Scouts USA face criticism over support for abortion, homosexuality, transgenderism, and contraception.

"It is very important today that a woman be adequately appreciated, and that she be able to take up fully the place that corresponds to her, be it in the Church, be it in society," Pope Francis said in his address on the morning of June 26, prior to the U.S. Supreme Court's decision imposing same-sex "marriage" on the country.

In the face of ideologies that seek to destroy the truths about marriage and family, he said, the formation of girls through Guiding "is absolutely determinant for the future."

"We are in a world in which the most contrary ideologies are spreading to the nature and design of God on the family and on marriage. Therefore, it is a question of educating girls not only to the beauty and grandeur of their vocation of women, in a just and differentiated relation between man and woman, but also to assume important responsibilities in the Church and in society," Pope Francis said.

Le diacre Ryan Al-lan Kaup, du Nebraska, revient de loin : sa mère souhaitait avorter avant de se ravisser ; il se prépare à devenir prêtre, à la grande joie de ses parents adoptifs.



Il y a trente-six ans de cela, une étudiante prenait rendez-vous pour un avortement. Elle était seule et craignait de ne pas avoir les moyens de s'occuper d'un bébé. Dans le doute, elle demande un second rendez-vous avec un autre médecin. Ce dernier connaissait un couple infertile, Randy et Sherry Kaup, et la jeune femme choisit finalement de leur confier son bébé, trois jours après sa naissance.

L'enfant grandit heureux au sein de cette famille pratiquante. Il fait ses études dans une école catholique. Sa vocation apparaît au cours de ses études supérieures et il décide d'intégrer le séminaire du diocèse de Lincoln. Ses parents adoptifs le soutiennent « Ils sont géniaux » confie-t-il en souriant à Lifenews. (« Il sourit toujours lorsqu'il parle de ses parents », précise le magazine.)

Pourtant son chemin vers le sacerdoce n'a pas été une vallée de roses. She was sent home diagnosed with a bruised sternum. Four days later, she collapsed and was rushed to the hospital. On May 14, three days after arriving at the hospital, she was pronounced dead. According to an article in Cosmopolitan, tests revealed a large blood clot on her lung.

Her name was Fallan Kurek, and she worked with disabled children in Tamworth, New South Wales, Australia. She had started taking the pill—a combination oral contraceptive—to regulate her menstrual cycle. Why wasn't Fallan warned about the possibility of blood clots that accompany pill use? Why did the hospital not immediately connect her symptoms to the contraceptive she had just started taking?

Fallan's devastated mother was quoted in the Birmingham Mail, "She was only on it to regulate her periods. I couldn't believe nobody had said the pill could do this. It should say it on the pack that they can kill and the label."

Annually, one in every 3000 women taking birth control pills will develop blood clots. It is well known all across the medical community that the pill increases the risk for deadly blood clots. And that information is indeed printed on the very lengthy packet insert, which most women never read. But it is not displayed on the packet, the label, or any other prominent place. And even knowing of the possibility of blood clots, medical personnel didn't connect the dots for Fallan Kurek.

405,000 people, 104 bishops sign petition to Pope Francis asking for 'clarification' on marriage

July 30, 2015 (LifeSiteNews) - Over 405,000 people, including 104 prelates - cardinals, archbishops, and bishops - have so far signed the "Filial Petition" to His Holiness Pope Francis asking for "a word of clarification" as the "only way to overcome the growing confusion among the faithful" on the issues of marriage, divorce, and homosexual unions.

In a press release, the organizers of the petition said today that "an intervention by the supreme authority is needed in order to counter the creeping advance of the Cultural Revolution promoted by anti-Christian forces, which for decades have sought to undermine people's moral convictions based on the Gospel and the Natural Law."

Among the signatories is Cardinal Raymond Burke, who himself personally issued a call widely reported in the media for Pope Francis to clarify the Church's teachings on sexuality last November.

His call for clarification came after weeks of confusion during the Vatican's Extraordinary Synod on the Family, where some bishops openly pushed for the Church to allow divorced and civilly remarried Catholics to receive communion, seemingly

with the tacit support of the pope. Others pushed for greater openness of the Church towards homosexuality.
